Computer Loan Agreement Covenant Christian School

Overview:

A computer owned by Covenant Christian School (CCS) is being loaned to the borrower (student, parent/guardian) for academic purposes while enrolled at CCS. It is the borrower's responsibility to take care of the equipment, keep it safe, and return it on time and in the same condition it was borrowed. It is also the borrower's responsibility to follow all school policies related to technology use, including, but not limited to the excerpts below. The borrower may not install, modify, or utilize any software on the computer other than that owned and installed by CCS.

Technology Fees:

If the computer is damaged, lost or stolen, the borrower must immediately inform their CCS teacher and will be responsible for the replacement cost of \$200. In addition, starting school year 2018-19, a technology fee will be collected to cover the cost of maintenance.

Privacy

There can be no expectation of privacy in school-provided equipment and services.

Privileges

The Use of Technology at Covenant Christian School is a privilege, not a right. The use of the Internet and other associated network access is a privilege, not a right, and inappropriate use will result in a cancellation of those privileges. The administration will deem what is inappropriate use and their decision is final. Also, the system administrators may deny access at any time as required and deemed appropriate.

Use of Covenant Christian School's technology resources must be in support of curriculum and research and consistent with the purposes, Mission Statement, and values of CCS. Should a student act in any manner inconsistent with the values of CCS as outlined in the Parent Student Handbook, then the student will enter the cycle of discipline as described in the same Parent Student Handbook.
