Thank you for your interest in Covenant Christian School! We offer a Preschool through 8<sup>th</sup> grade program and have been serving the community since 1985. In the fall of 2019, we celebrated 35 years in Christian education, and we're stronger than ever! In addition to our regular program, we also offer the following International Student Programs:

**Short-term Program:**

Covenant Christian School began its acceptance of short-term international students in the 2006-2007 school year, and we have continued to receive international students each year since. In this program, students visit CCS on a short-stay basis, usually for a period of six to eight weeks that coincides with the 'winter break' in their home country. Due to the significant success of our program and word-of-mouth sharing of their experience at CCS, we have averaged fifteen short-term international students, per year, in grades K-8, since our program's inception. Students come for the experience and for the acquisition of English skills. Several students have returned for additional short-stay periods in the year or two following their initial stay. During their time at CCS, students are fully immersed in classroom curriculum, gain a better understanding of English, learn about Jesus through daily bible lessons and weekly chapel attendance, make friends, and have a great time! We were blessed in the 2019-2020 school year to have thirty-two visiting international students spend an average of 6.3 weeks each at CCS!

The forms needed for short-term visitation for international students are as follows: Emergency Contact Form & International Students Financial Agreement Form. The Financial Agreement Form for Visiting (Short-term) International Students includes the tuition cost and the terms and conditions of the program.

**Full-time Program:**

We are proud to announce that CCS is also authorized through the Student Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) to issue I-20 forms and accept full-time international students. We will accept full-time international students in fourth through eighth grades. We are committed to providing an environment in which each student can thrive academically, socially, and spiritually. We are fully confident that through their total immersion in the day-to-day classroom activities and their daily interactions with students, teachers and staff members at CCS, they will grow socially and academically, while gaining a better understanding of, and ability to use, the English language. **Note:** Acceptance of full-time international students in grades lower than fourth, especially in cases where an older sibling is enrolled at CCS, may be permitted with the prior approval of the CCS Principal.

SECTION D: EXTENDED DAY CARE RATE per Visiting International Student

School Hours are 8:00am to 2:40pm. Morning Day Care is available from 7:00am to 7:45am. Students dropped off before 7:45am will be charged at the rate of \$9 per hour for Morning Extended Day Care. Students not picked up by 3:00pm, will be charged \$9 per hour for Afternoon Extended Day Care. Afternoon Day Care Hours are 3:00pm to 6:00pm.

Extended Day Care charges incurred must be paid in the month in which they were used. Outstanding charges are due no later than the last day of school the visiting student attends at CCS before returning to home country.

SECTION E: Enrollment Form will not be accepted without payment of the first full month's tuition.

We affirm that we have read and understand the tuition information and enrollment policies at CCS and agree to keep all financial obligations current and abide by the terms and conditions noted above.
